STARTING YOUR

Pick up and set down points (Map left)

- Park in Terrigal where free buses shuttle you to MacMasters Beach 7.00am - 10.30am
- Pick up is from **Point F** Entrance of Crowne Plaza Terrigal, Pinetree Lane or **Point G** - Terrigal Haven
- Set down is at **Point A** Warri Cres, MacMasters Beach
- Register Walk 750m downhill to the MacMasters Beach Surf Club for registration and events
- Captain Cook Lookout Shuttle runs 8.00am 1.30pm, between Point B - Copacabana Surf Club and Point C - Captain Cook Lookout

Visiting from Palm Beach (Small map below)

Palm Beach via Ettalong

- Catch the Palm Beach Ferry **Point H** to **Point G** Ettalong
- Shuttles will meet ferry arrivals to take you to the start at Point A - MacMasters Beach via Ettalong
- Throughout the day shuttles will run from Point F Terrigal, Pine Tree Lane and return to MacMasters Beach. You'll change buses to Ettalong Wharf

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GETTING AROUND DURING THE DAY

From 10.30am the shuttle loops around the 5 Lands Walk to:

- Point A MacMasters Beach
- **Point B** Copacabana
- Point D Avoca Beach
- **Point E** North Avoca; and
- Point F Terrigal

Last bus to Ettalong Wharf leaves Terrigal at 4.15pm. You'll need to change bus at MacMasters Beach then on to Ettalong to catch the last Ferry to Palm Beach at 5:30pm.

Important Notes:

The Haven is pick up only from 7.00am - 10.30am direct to Macmasters Beach, then closed for the day.

Go to **Point F**, rear Crowne Plaza Terrigal in Pinetree Lane for all stops transport from that time service frequency varies throughout the day with services concentrating around the time of major ceremonies at each Land.

▲ 11. The finish line is in site at Point F (C,10) Turn left to the events at **Terrigal Surf Club**

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- 10. Take care crossing the Scenic Hwy into Kurrawyba Ave and follow it to the beach
- Now follow North Avoca Pde, The Arena and Coast Rd to Scenic Hwy
- Celebrate Connection to Country at Point E (H, 8) Walk up the beach to North Avoca
- You've reached the half mark at Point D (L, 7)
- Turn right, and after 100m enter the pathway that starts on the corner of Endeavour Dr (between the houses) down the hill

Cross the park and head to the Avoca Beach Surf Club and Hunter Park near Avoca **Beach Picture Theatre**

- Follow the path and signs to the Fire Trail that leads up to the water tower on Cape Three Points Rd
- 5. Walking back from the lookout, turn right and follow Del Monte Pde for 475 metres to the park on your right
- 4. Immerse yourself in whale watching at POINT C (U, 10) Turn right at the top to Captain Cook Lookout
- 3. Continue along Del Monte Pde and head up the hill
- 2. Arriving at POINT B (V,5) After registering, walk north along the beach to Copacabana
- 1. Begin at POINT A (S,2) The shuttle sets down and picks up only at Warri Cres. Walk down Marine Pde to the desk and REGISTER at MacMasters Beach Surf Club



Shuttle Bus drops you off at Point A (S,2) - Warri Cres where you'll walk to the registration desk at the Surf Club end of Marine Pde.
