PART ONE - ART IN THE OPEN 5 LANDS WALK, June 24, 2023

1. Turning up on the day and completing work outside regardless of the weather, though of course it WILL be sunny , from 10.00am - 4.00pm on Saturday June 24, 2023.

2. Taking the days' work(s) from 5.30pm – 7.00pm for Artists' After Party and Artists' Choice Award at the Crowne Plaza Terrigal. Each artist has the opportunity to choose 3 artists (not themselves) who they feel did the best work or works on the day.
