Getting here by train

The nearest train station to the 5 Lands Walk is Woy Woy, on the Sydney to Newcastle line.

Getting here by ferry

The Palm Beach ferry operates regularly from Palm Beach to Ettalong.

Fare is \$24.40 return, \$12.20 concession or child (price correct at time of printing).

Timetables are shown in this brochure.

Our free shuttle bus will meet the ferry to take you to the start at MacMasters Beach. Our shuttle bus can then return you to Ettalong from MacMasters Beach.

Getting here by car

If you are driving, we recommend you leave your car at Terrigal and catch our free shuttle bus to the start at MacMasters Beach. Then walk the 5 Lands Walk back to Terrigal or take the shuttle bus back to Terrigal to collect your car. Parking at MacMasters Beach is **EXTREMELY** limited.

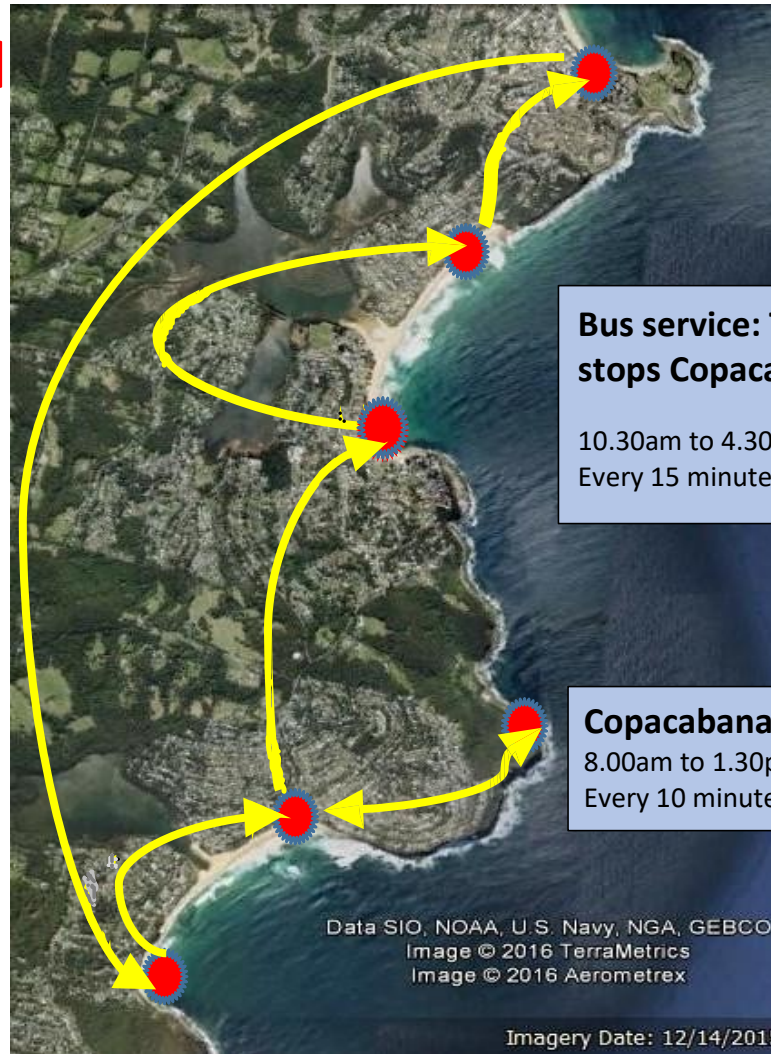
